If a guest is approved, the behavior of the guest is the responsibility of the graduate sponsor. If the guest is asked to leave the prom, the graduate sponsor must leave as well. We allow one guest per graduating student.

This form is to be completed and brought in by the student prior to payment for a prom ticket - tickets are \$100.00 each.
