Melanie Armstrong – SPEAC Rep

New Healthy Schools Website – the school board is working on a new healthy schools website which will feature teachers and kids from schools around the district.

Healthy Schools Committee Meeting – 7:15pm on February 17th at the School Board office, they welcome any who would like to join their group.

Emergency Release Drill – will be conducted at some point this year in every elementary school, so if you have a child in elementary school please remember to add to their school's emergency contact list the names of anyone who would be permitted to pick up your child in an emergency such as an earthquake.

Skate Park Plans? – as yet no site has been chosen for a new skate park to replace the one at the old Belmont. SPEAC will be writing a letter to the City of Langford and the City of Colwood to express our support in finding a new location as soon as possible.

Curriculum Discussion Night – tentatively on March 2nd from 7-9pm there will be an open discussion night for parents and all interested people to discuss the new school curriculum. I'll provide the location once it's determined.

Transportation Night Recap – On January 19th I went to the transportation meeting at Royal Bay and it was pretty fascinating. I counted 29 people in attendance, and half were presenters and representatives from the school board, Colwood and Langford city councils, BC Transit, the CRD, etc. It was clear from the meeting that the school board doesn't want to provide busing at all, and is only interested in finding ways to facilitate our children getting to school by alternate methods. Many excellent suggestions were made about improving walking and busing routes, using public transit, etc., but any discussion about finding efficiencies in the current school busing situation was put off until some future meeting.

At our recent SPEAC meeting I pressed the School Superintendent on when we would have a meeting to discuss the school busing issues (which cost the district and parents over 4 million a year), and I was told, hopefully by the end of February. No date has been selected as yet, but they will post it on the school board website when they know. If anyone wants more info please get in touch with me.

New School Calendar – the proposed school calendars for the next two years are on the school board website. Please provide your input.

CUPE Update – Tim from the CUPE office spoke about some of the challenges they're having now that their old facility is gone.
