Belmont Prom is a school event and all students are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct in order to ensure that our prom is a safe and fun event. Please go over the expectations below with your child.

Upon entering, students and their guests will be searched and will be asked to take a breathalyzer. If they are found to have banned substances, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol, they will be denied entry to the prom (along with their guest, if they have one). If a guest is approved, the behaviour of the guest is the responsibility of the graduate sponsor. If the guest is asked to leave the prom, the graduate sponsor must leave as well. We allow one guest per graduating student.

This form is to be completed and brought in by the student prior to payment for a prom ticket - tickets are \$100.00 each. This completed form is due back to the office by May 19th with payment of \$100.00. You may pay by cash/cheque or call in credit card number to 250-478-5501 ext 2157 (Kay Fenn).
