

## Distributed Learning/Online Course Registration for Grade 9-12

The WestShore Langford Campus offers a variety of options for School District 62 (Sooke) students/families interested in taking distributed learning (DL) courses. We recommend that students start with registering for 1 or 2 WestShore online courses while staying registered with their current SD#62 high school. This is called 'cross-enrolment' and keeps a reserved space for the student in their current high school. The student's timetable at their regular school stays in place just in case they decide to attend in-person classes at some point later in the school year or if a student wants to accelerate their learning, they may choose to take additional courses. The student will continue to have access to the supports offered by their current school including their school counsellor.

**To register as a cross-enrolled student** complete the <u>WestShore Langford Campus Cross Enrolled Student Learning Plan</u>. This form can also be accessed on our <u>website</u>. You will be contacted by WestShore staff and provided with access to your requested course(s) once your registration is processed.

Parents of grade 9 students should select the '20<sup>th</sup> Century World History 12'course and the WestShore office will contact you to select the grade 9 course(s). Grade 9 courses are not included on our online registration form as these are only available for SD62 students.

Students who are not planning to attend their block A course at their current school are encouraged to sign up for the same course. For example, if a student is scheduled for Science 10 in block A, they would choose Science 10 as their first DL course.

Students who want to take a DL course in addition to attending their in-person class(es) should use the same registration  $\underline{\text{form}}$ .
