- Focus on: Teamwork & collaboration, Leadership, Problem solving & critical thinking, Work ethic & persistence,
 - Organizational skills, Creativity,
 - Interpersonal communication, Relationship skills (e.g. conflict resolution)
- AVID is a linear (all year) program, paired with English.


